

Dear parent/ carer

I hope this letter finds you and your families well, considering the current unprecedented circumstances. I firstly wish to communicate that as a school we want to ensure that every pupil has the best support possible to make the transition from Year 6 to Year 7. The transition process is a milestone in a pupil's academic and personal development and it is important that we acknowledge that the current situation has disrupted some, but not all elements of transition.

Thanks to the primary schools and the powers of virtual technology we have been able to start to get to know your children. However, it is important that they too start to learn a little more about us and the school, to remove any possible worries they may have about starting in September. With this in mind we have procured a short transition film covering the following information about the school:

- **The Year 7 pastoral team** An introduction from the key members of staff that will play an integral role in your child's academic and pastoral progress whilst at secondary school.

- **Frequently ask questions** Current Year 7 pupils will articulate their personal experiences when joining Olchfa and answer some of the questions they had when they first started.
