

## Arrangements for Years 11-13 May/June 2022

With the significant disruption to teaching and learning over the past two years, we recognise that pupils need support as they approach the exam period. Whilst the exam board adaptations have gone some way to reducing the content burden in many subjects, there is still a lot of work to do. Pupils have missed a lot of learning and we need to minimise the impact of this by ensuring we continue to offer face to face teaching to support examination preparation.

The arrangements for pupils in each year group are outlined below:

### Year 11

Year 11 will be in timetabled lessons up to and including Friday 27<sup>th</sup> May. Where pupils have completed all the exams/assessments in a subject prior to this date, they will be expected to bring in revision materials for other subjects for use in these lessons.

From Monday 6<sup>th</sup> June the Yr 11 timetable will be suspended, pupils will only need to be in school for their remaining exams but may elect to attend intensive revision sessions run by subject staff during this period. This timetable will be centralised and co-ordinated by ATB.

### Year 12

Year 12 are expected to attend all timetabled lessons for a subject up to and including Friday 13<sup>th</sup> May. From this date, students will continue to attend all subject lessons until the completion of all the examinations/assessments in that subject. The only exception to this is for sessions immediately prior to an external exam. In this instance, the student will be permitted to study at home for the morning or afternoon immediately prior to the exam. E.g. For an afternoon exam they may study at home on the morning of the exam; for a morning exam, they may study at home on the afternoon of the previous day.

Once all the examinations in a subject are completed, attendance in the lessons for that subject will not be required until Monday 13<sup>th</sup> June. From Monday 13<sup>th</sup> June, all Yr 12 students will be required to attend all their timetabled lessons.

**Note:** Y12 Double Maths students who have an examination on Thursday 21 June will be permitted to study at home on the morning of the 21<sup>st</sup> June.

### Year 13

Year 13 will be expected to attend all timetabled lessons up to and including Friday 20<sup>th</sup> May. From this date, students will continue to attend subject lessons until the completion of all the examinations/assessments in that subject. The only exception to this is for sessions immediately prior to an external exam. In this instance, the student will be permitted to study at home for the morning or afternoon immediately prior to the exam. E.g. For an afternoon exam they may study at home on the morning of the exam; for a morning exam, they may study at home on the afternoon of the previous day.

Once all the examinations in a subject are completed, attendance in lessons for that subject will not be required.
